The North Bakersfield Recreation and Park District's mission is to provide recreation and park services through planning, organizing and conducting a wide variety of recreation programs and community services for all ages; and to acquire, develop and maintain parks and natural and cultural resources within the district for the betterment, use and inspiration of the public we serve.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Public Resources Code 5780, et. seq.

TERM: Four year term.

QUALIFICATIONS: Five Board Members: Three appointed by the Kern County Board of Supervisors and two appointed by the City Council of Bakersfield. Members must be registered voters and reside within the District.

DUTIES: To provide the District with clearly defined goals and objectives in support of its mission; to provide and maintain an adequate program of recreation activities and a system of areas and facilities designed to support them; to establish rules and regulations governing internal organization and operation.

MEETINGS: District Office, 405 Galaxy Avenue, on the third Monday of each month at 5:30 p.m. If the third Monday falls on a legal state holiday, the meeting will be held on the Tuesday following the holiday.
