

KERN MOSQUITO ABATEMENT AND VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT

The primary objective of the Kern Mosquito Abatement District is the elimination of mosquito-breeding areas by way of educational services, various control measures and abatement procedure methods when necessary. This member is nominated and appointed by the Council of each respective participating City.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Health & Safety Code Section 2240, et seq.

TERM: Two year staggered term. Appointments are made in December.

QUALIFICATIONS: Eight Trustees: four appointed by the Kern County Board of Supervisors, one each by City Councils of Bakersfield, Arvin, Shafter, and Wasco. Each member appointed by governing board of the city shall be an elector of the city and a resident of that portion of the city which is within the Kern Mosquito Abatement District.

DUTIES: The primary objective shall be the progressive elimination of mosquito-breeding places, the objective to be accomplished by an educational service on control measures, performing services of temporary relief control, establishing projects of source reduction, using abatement procedure methods when necessary, and by general policy of cooperation.
