

METROPOLITAN BAKERSFIELD HABITAT CONSERVATION PLAN TRUST GROUP

The Metropolitan Bakersfield Habitat Conservation Plan Trust Group is appointed by the City Council and County of Kern respectively and is composed of five (5) members.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Joint Powers Agreement
(City of Bakersfield Agreement No. 93-168)
(Kern County Agreement No. 387-93)

TERM: Two (2) years

QUALIFICATIONS: Must be a resident of the City of Bakersfield when the appointment is made by the City Council; some knowledge of the workings of the Metropolitan Bakersfield Habitat Conservation Plan; ability to attend Trust Group meetings during business hours.

DUTIES: The Trust Group develops and adopts rules and regulations governing the conduct of the Agency. The Trust Group shall also develop, audit and review procedures to assist in ensuring compliance with Section 10 (a) (1) (B) and 2081 Permit Implementing Agreement. The public member acts in an advisory capacity to the Trust and provides input on decisions regarding preserve land acquisition and management, and direction to Trust staff.

MEETINGS: Meets on scheduled dates, Kern County Administrative Building, 1115 Truxtun Avenue.
