

BAKERSFIELD REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

The Bakersfield Redevelopment Agency (BRDA) is an advisory body to the City Council. It is composed of seven (7) members, appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Council.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Municipal Code Chapter 2.24

TERM: Four (4) years, with a two (2) consecutive term limit. Appointments are made in April.

QUALIFICATIONS: Members must be registered voters and residents of the City throughout their terms. BRDA Members represent any variety of professional backgrounds and experience for the development of the central city, including, but not limited to business, finance, architecture, engineering, public relations and real estate.

DUTIES: Transact business and exercise its powers under the community redevelopment law. The BRDA has authority to approve all development agreements subject to approval by the City Council two-thirds vote.

MEETINGS: Meets on calendared Mondays at 4:00 p.m., Council Chambers, City Hall, 1501 Truxtun Avenue, Bakersfield.

REMUNERATION: Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) for each monthly meeting attended. No Member shall receive compensation for attending more than two Agency meetings during any calendar month. In addition, Members shall receive their actual and necessary expenses, including traveling expenses, incurred in the discharge of their duties.
