

## **FIRE DEPARTMENT CIVIL SERVICE BOARD**

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The Fire Department Civil Service Board is an advisory body to the City Council. It is composed of three (3) members, appointed by the full Council.

**LEGAL AUTHORITY:** City Charter Section 183.

**TERM:** Three (3) years. Appointments are made in December.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Members must be residents of the City throughout their terms, but who otherwise shall have no connection with City Government.

**DUTIES:** The Commission formulates rules and regulations governing the selection, promotion and discipline of members of the Fire Department.

**MEETINGS:** Meets the second Monday of each month at 3:00 p.m., Fire Station No. 1, 2101 H Street. All meetings are open to the public and last approximately one hour. Members may also be requested to sit on special board meetings to review disability and/or disciplinary action for another Civil Service Board within the City of Bakersfield.

**REMUNERATION:** Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) a month when a meeting is held.
