

# HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

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The Historic Preservation Commission is an advisory body to the City Council. It is composed of five (5) members appointed by the full Council.

**LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Municipal Code Section 15.72.040 (amended 4/13/05)

**TERM:** Three (3) year

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Members must be residents of the City throughout their term.

**DUTIES:** The Historic Preservation Commission reviews applications for Cultural Resource designations and historic districts; presides and conducts public hearings on such applications and makes recommendations to the City Council. Additionally, the Commission reviews and comments on applications as may be referred to the Commission by the Planning Commission, Board of Zoning Adjustment or the City Council.

**MEETINGS:** Meetings are held as needed on the third Tuesday of each month, at 4:00 p.m. at City Hall North, 1600 Truxtun Avenue, First Floor, Conference Room B.
