



Due to the large number of rainouts that occurred in the Spring Season, the Fall Softball Season is running behind. As we discussed in the Managers Meeting the following Rainout Rules will apply to the 2016 Fall Softball Season.

1. We have predesignated the following two weekends for makeup games:
 - a. December 10th & 11th
 - b. December 17th & 18th
2. All teams must be prepared to play on the two weekends listed above if any of their games are postponed by League Administration for (weather, lights, lack of an umpire, or unsafe field conditions).
3. The League Administration reserves the right to reschedule, move games and change game times as necessary. This means we may reschedule your game to be played before the two designated weekends as we have done in the past. The Leagues Modified Rules & Regulations gives more detail in regard to rescheduling games on page 5 under Field Conditions.
4. Rescheduled games will be posted on our website.
5. If your game cannot be rescheduled by League Administration a refund of \$40 per game will be processed for the person/sponsor that payed for the team registration.
6. If all the games for your Division cannot be played/rescheduled, then the final standings will be decided by using the "Winningest Percentage".
7. When using Winningest Percentage if not all games were played for a week then that week's games will be dropped. (For example in week 3, only two out of three games were completed. Assuming the third game could not be rescheduled by League Administration then week 3 would be dropped when determining the Winningest Percentage.)
8. In the case of a three way or more tie for First 1st place, the League will use our standard tie breaking procedures to determine the top two teams.
9. No Championship games will be held this season. Both teams tied for first will receive shirts and the League will use our standard tie breaking procedures to determine who gets the smaller trophy.
10. Friday night will play their final game on Monday, December, 19th.
