YOU MUST HAVE AND MAINTAIN A CUMULATIVE G.P.A. OF 2.0 ("C" OR BETTER IN EACH CLASS)
YOU MUST NOT ENGAGE IN ALCOHOL AND DRUGS
YOU MUST BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER
YOU MAY NOT HAVE ANY FELONY CONVICTIONS
IF UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE YOU MUST HAVE PARENTAL CONSENT AND SUPPORT
