Due to ongoing restrictions and precautions being taken amidst the Coronavirus pandemic, the City of Bakersfield Animal Control unit would like to notify city residents the November 14th, 2020 vaccine clinic is scheduled to be held at Kroll Park at 7500 Kroll Way, with the following safeguards:

1. Clinic stations will be set up near the dog park entrance.
2. Street parking is available on several surrounding streets.
3. Customers will be provided forms that must be completed prior to services.
4. Customer will be also be given a specified time frame when they can exit their vehicle with their pet and get in line, with their completed form.
5. Customers without vehicles will be asked to return at the designated time for services.
6. Pets will be handled by staff when possible.
7. While in line, a minimum distance of 6 feet from all others in line will be enforced.
8. One person per animal (2 MAXIMUM only if owner needs assistance controlling animal).
9. Bi-lingual staff will be available; customers do not need to bring an interpreter.
10. All customers will be required to wear masks. NO MASK, NO SERVICE.

We look forward to serving the community and providing resources for local families and their pets. Your patience and understanding during this new process is much appreciated.

Kroll Park

Saturday, Nov 14th

9:00 AM TO 12:00 PM

THE FOLLOWING SAFEGUARDS WILL BE IMPLEMENTED:

1. Clinic stations will be set up near the park entrance.
2. Street parking will be available.
3. Upon sign-in, customers will be given forms, a specified time to return to have their pet vaccinated, and advised to stay in their vehicles or relocate to fill out their forms.
4. Customers are encouraged to disperse or wait in their vehicle; NO GATHERING near the clinic is allowed.
5. Pets will be handled by staff only.
6. Six feet minimum distance between individuals will be enforced.
7. One person per animal; if a second person is needed to help control 2 MAXIMUM.
8. Bi-lingual staff will be available.
9. All customers will be required to wear a face mask or covering. **NO MASK, NO SERVICE.**
